Terms and Conditions (page 1 of 2)

These are the contractual elements of the Japan 101 Tour scheduled for Spring 2018 between *LetsGoToJapanNow* (an i-BEAK Inc. owned entity) and the tour guest listed on the application above.

Note: Prices are in Japanese Yen (JPY) and converted to U.S. Dollars (USD) on a 110 JPY to 1 USD rate. Any variations in the exchange rate will be trued up in the final payment due prior to departure.

Prices are based on dual occupancy of rooms. Single occupancy rates add 20%.

- 10-12 Guests: 396,000¥ or \$3,600 per guest.
- 8-10 Guests: 418,000¥ or \$3,800 per guest.
- 6-8 Guests: 440,000¥ or \$4,000 per guest.

This price includes:

- 10 days and 9 nights in Japan, all lodging and group transportation provided.
- Continental breakfasts provided each morning. Lunches provided all but three days (free time provided during those days to eat at a variety of local restaurants of your choice). Dinners provided for all nine nights, providing a variety of Japanese cuisine.
- All transportation provided except during free times. Transportation includes chartered buses, trains, bullet train (Shinkansen), and domestic (within Japan) airfare.
- A Japanese-native, English-fluent Tour Director will accompany and support the group every day except during your “free time” periods. Localized tour guides have been hand selected for certain cities and temples, where specific expertise is required.
- Temple, Shrine, and Museum fees for scheduled events.

Your Responsibilities:

- **Air fare to Haneda Airport:** You are responsible for your arrival in Japan on March 29, 2018
- **Luggage:** Each guest is limited to one check-in bag and one small travel bag. *LetsGoToJapanNow* will accommodate your check-in bags except on the Shinkansen. **You are responsible for managing your own luggage aboard the Shinkansen, please pack accordingly.**
- **Physical Abilities:** Japan does not abide by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). You must be able to walk at least two kilometers (1.25 miles) unassisted, including steps and gravel pathways.
- **Documents:** A valid passport is required to travel in Japan. Your passport expiration date **must be later than 10/7/2018 or you may not be admitted through Japanese immigration.**
- **Money:** Visa cards and ATM cash cards are recommended. Japan is primarily a cash-based market system and you will likely need JPY on hand in order to make small purchases. **Be sure to coordinate with your banks before you leave to let them know you'll be abroad.**

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A deposit of \$1,500 is required to secure your reservation on this tour. Deadlines, go/no go date, cancellations, and deposit refunds are shown in the schedule listed below:

Payment Requirements and Schedule:

Spring 2018 Japan 101 Tour. Leaving the U.S. on March 28, 2018; arriving in Japan on March 29.

- **November 15, 2017:** Guest application and deposit due.
- **December 15, 2017:** Go/no go decision—determination if the tour will go forward based on participation. If the tour will not go forward, your complete deposit will be refunded.
- **January 15, 2018:** Cancellation deadline. Cancellations will be accepted until this date. \$750 will be refunded upon cancellation. **Note:** cancellations must be made in writing by the deadline.
- **January 31, 2018:** Balance of the tour cost is due. Failure to pay by this date will be understood as a late cancellation that does not qualify for a deposit refund.

Liability:

LetsGoToJapanNow acts only as a Tour Operator/Coordinator for transportation companies, hotels, and other public services and it is the express condition that travel services shall not become liable for delays, losses or accidents incurred by said persons or operators to passengers and baggage from whatever cause.
